Wither Hills Sauvignon Blanc 2010

Normal \$35.80 **OFFER \$30.43** (incl. GST)

Sam Kim Wine Orbit 5 stars & 93 Pts - "You can see why this is one of the most popular Sauvignons, as it delivers loads of tasty flavours. The nose is ripe and fragrant with a lovely combination of ripe stonefruit and feijoa with lime and herbaceous characters. It's succulent and full-flavoured on the palate with beautifully harmonised acidity, leaving the palate refreshed and wanting more". Wine Spectator: Wonderfully fleshy with peach, apple, nectarine and citrus flavours that are ripe, lush and very refreshing. The details linger on the finish. 90 Pts. Villa Maria Cellar Selection Chardonnay 2009

Normal \$38.10 **OFFER \$32.39** (incl. GST)

A Marlborough Chardonnay which spends 10 months in oak barriques. Displays a tight youthful bouquet of citrus lemon and stonefruit, with hints of lime, cashew and complex oatmeal notes. The palate has richness and texture in balance with a gentle acidity. Lovely refinement, balance and length. Silver Medal Air New Zealand Wine Awards.

Ata Rang Pinot Gris 2010

Normal \$48.60 **OFFER \$41.31** (incl. GST)

The Pinot Gris is always picked late season, with lusciously ripe, golden pear and almond-nougat aromas openly expressed in the finished wine. Hints of fresh nectarine complete the long, fine finish. With just 8g/l residual sugar, it is a delicious stand-alone aperitif, and perfect Asian influenced food.

Villa Maria Single Vineyard Sauvignon Blanc Taylor Pass 2009

Normal \$54.90 **OFFER \$46.67** (incl. GST)

Pungent aromatics of ripe gooseberry, passionfruit and grapefruit pith, with a concentrated and layered palate of currants, tropical fruit and subtle minerality - leading to a lingering lime finish. Excellent balance of fruit and acidity with a hint of chalky textured complexity providing elegance and length.

93/100 Bob Campbell "From the Awatere Valley and showing typical grassy, tomato leaf and mineral characters. Robust wine with lovely juicy acidity and a lengthy finish. Richly textured Sauvignon with impressive weight. Should develop well."

Domaine Chanson Pernand Vergelesses Les Caradeux Premier Cru 2008

Normal \$72.60 **OFFER \$61.71** (incl. GST)

The vineyard is well-situated halfway up the slope near the vineyard of Corton-Charlemagne, and possesses the same geology and altitude as its illustrious neighbour, but faces East. An exceptional terroir with intense minerality. A pale yellow colour, lemon on the nose with fresh honey and wheat. An attractive minerality is encased by subtle oak. The wine is well-structured with a lovely textural quality. Good mineral definition and excellent acidity. The finish is linear and intense. Mitchell Peppertree Shiraz 2008

Normal \$41.80 **OFFER \$35.53** (incl. GST)

"Bright purple-crimson hue; dry-grown, hand-picked estate grapes have produced a lovely wine, supple and smooth in the mouth, with vibrant cherry and plum fruit, good oak and sweet tannins. The best Peppertree Vineyard Shiraz to date." 2012 Edition of James Halliday's Australian Wine Companion.

Trinity Hill GG Tempranillo 2008

Normal \$47.00 **OFFER \$39.95** (incl. GST)

87% Tempranillo, 10% Touriga Nacional, 2% Malbec and 1% Viognier. The predominant grape is Spain's most widely planted, and best known for making Rioja. Wild raspberry and plum fruit aromas with spice characterise the wine, with a little vanillin from oak barrels. This is a result of fully ripened fruit under temperate conditions. Malbec adds depth and weight and spice to the wine. The texture is firm but supple, and the wine is elegant, with a great persistence of the wild berry and licorice flavours on the finish. Villa Maria Cellar Selection Pinot Noir 2009

Perfumed cherry & plum bouquet with spice. Complex rich pinot with layers of flavour. Fine grainy tannins.

Dauvergne Ranvier Gigondas Vin Rare 2007

Normal \$50.80 **OFFER \$43.18** (incl. GST)

This exceptional wine benefits from the Appellations very high number of sunshine hours and very low yields. The name Gigondas derives from the Latin *Jocundities* - meaning pleasure! The vineyards are on dry hillsides on high ground with poor terrain, old vines, and exposure to the Mistral. 85% Grenache, 10% Syrah, the rest Cinsault and Mourvèdre. A nose which exudes the scents of Provence, a supple ripe mouth-feel which seems to increase in power to an amazing long finish. 91 Pts Stephen Tanzer. 91 Pts Wine Spectator. 91 Pts Robert Parker.

Pegasus Bay Pinot Noir 2008

Normal \$66.30 **OFFER \$56.36** (incl. GST)

A complex intertwining of fruity and savoury aromas and flavours. Wild cherry, raspberries and mulberries mingle with impressions of roast game, grilled mushroom, black olives and liquorice. The wine expands richly in the mouth, and the initial seductive fruitiness leads to a backbone of ripe tannins giving structure, depth and length. There is a lingering impression of dark chocolate.
